

TECHNICAL RIDER

Sound, stage & lighting

- PA system from a reputable manufacturer (Turbosound, EAW, D&B, Nexo, etc). Mackie, Peavey, TOA, Behringer or similar manufactures are not acceptable;
- The system power must be suitable for the size of the room and the type of the client; (minimum 3.000W and 10.000W for outdoor events)
- 4 wireless transmitters for 2 violins, cello and keyboard;
- DI for all the instruments;
- Keyboard (Roland Juno DI or Fantom) + stand;
- 2 wireless mikes with stands;
- 4 wireless In-Ear for feedback control (same manufacturer/model);
- 4 fold back monitors minimum 300 W on the stage (back-up feedback control);
- Mixing desk minimum 8 channels with effects - reverb and delay;
- Professional CD player for backing tracks;
- Amadeus require a full 1 hour sound check.

During the sound check the stage must be illuminated without any cables or other materials on stage to avoid any accident;

- An experienced system technician (english speaker) should be present during the sound check and the show to ensure that the system is running properly;
- Staging area to be no smaller 6x3 meters;
- The stage is to be well lit at all the time so that the performance is clearly visible;
- Intelligent lights, strobes and smoke or haze machines to enhance the show.

Hospitality at venue

- A separate and secure dressing room with exclusive access for Amadeus only with a full length mirror;
- Still water, soft drinks, tea and coffee, fruits, sandwiches for 6 persons.

Flights & transfers

- 6 X flights tickets (with one extra baggage for cello);
- Transfer airport – hotel – venue.

Accommodation & meals

- 2 DBL rooms and 2 single on the same floor at a minimum 4 stars hotel, as close as possible to the venue;
- Breakfast, lunch and dinner for all team.

* This rider is generic and is designed to cater for all events in as much depth as possible. However, as all events are different we accept that you may need to make alterations or substitutions in certain places. This is usually fine as long as they are discussed and agreed in advance of the show.
